92% of respondents **strongly agreed** that they felt confident in their ability to apply what was learned.

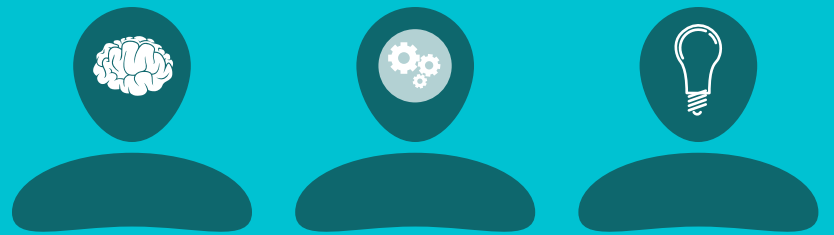


93% of respondents **strongly agreed** that workshop facilitators were knowledgeable.
