Volunteer Requirements

- 18 years old or older
- Complete a 60 hour in-person/online training
- Commit to monthly on-call responsibility with access to a vehicle
- Dedicate one year of service under the supervision of the Volunteer Supervisor
- Attend 6+ volunteer meetings/trainings per year
- Provide support that is compassionate, empathetic, and victim-centered

Mondays and Wednesdays: July 16th, 18th, 23rd, 25th, 30th, and
August 1st, 6th, 8th, 13th, 15th, & Aug.20th (final day)
