Volunteer Requirements

- 18 years old or older
 - Complete a 60-hour in-person/online training
 - Commit to on-call responsibility with access to a vehicle
 - Dedicate a year of service under the supervision of the Volunteer Supervisor
 - Attend 6 volunteer meetings/trainings per year
 - Provide support that is compassionate, empathetic, and victim-centered

Our next 60-hour training program will take place in person from 5 p.m. — 9 p.m. on Mondays and Wednesdays, February 4th, 6th, 11th, 13th, 20th, 25th, 27th and March 4th, 6th 11th, 13th, 18th and ending on March 20th.
