

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak, we can't assemble in person for our annual 5K this year - but we're bringing our heroes together for Heroes on the Hunt for Hope, a **virtual fundraiser and scavenger hunt** from April 28 - May 2!

Given the new format of this year's event, we've taken the time to answer some of your questions:



When can I register?

We highly recommend registering by April 27, but registration will remain open through May 2!



Can children register?

Yes! Children under 16 can be added to any adult registration. Kids who participate will receive a printable certificate via email at the end of the event.

When will I receive my official scavenger hunt sheet?



Scavenger hunt sheets will be emailed to each registered participant on April 27. Participants who register after April 27 will receive their sheet on the date of registration.

Where will the scavenger hunt take place?



Safety first! Search for items in your homes and surrounding areas, all while practicing good social distancing (+6 feet away from nonhousehold members at all times). If all else fails, you can take your search online or draw your "finds"!



Can I still do a 5K?

Yes, if you wish! While we've shifted our model, participants are welcome to add a little speed to their hunt and incorporate a run or walk into this activity, if they prefer.

Do I have to take all five days for the scavenger hunt?

It's up to you! We recommend extending the fun across all five days and joining us by posting your special finds daily, but you can complete the hunt however you like within that timeframe. NJCASA will only be sharing your photos and videos on social media between April 28 - May 2, though - be sure to use #NJCASAHuntForHope if you want us to see them!

Will my social media entries be featured?
