Bilingual Child Counselor

The Bilingual Counselor is responsible for providing clinical services to children and families using the Trauma Focused-Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) model. The Counselor reports directly to the Clinical Psychologist.

Job Qualifications

The Bilingual Counselor must successfully complete the 60-hour Sexual Violence, Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking Training provided by Services Empowering Rights of Victims. The Counselor must have experience working with victims and survivors of trauma. Effective verbal and written communication skills in English and Spanish are required. Prior experience working with children and teens is preferred and experience in play, art or music therapy. This position requires a Master's Degree in Psychology, Social Work or a related field. A New Jersey State license for professional counseling is required and prior training in TF-CBT.

Duties and Responsibilities

Obtain TF-CBT certification if not already received.

Provide individual counseling to survivors of trauma and their non-offending family members and significant others.

Work with the Bilingual Child Advocate ensuring client needs are met.

Provide survivors with case-related medical and legal information.

Provide appropriate referrals for survivors.

Provide technical assistance, training and consultations to program partners.

Provide community awareness and education.
