

Volunteers Needed for Morris County Sexual Assault Response Team (SART)

Become a Confidential Sexual Violence Advocate by completing a **FREE 40- Hour Training Program!** Volunteers are required to live within an hour of **Morristown, New Jersey**.

Morris County Sexual Assault Center is a program within Atlantic Health System, funded by the Division of Children and Families, which offers **free** counseling services to survivors and their families of sexual assault who reside in Morris County.

During the 40-hour Confidential Sexual Violence Advocate training volunteers are educated on topics regarding sexual assault, prevention, crisis intervention and advocacy support skills. Once the training is complete, volunteers will be responsible for managing three, 12-hour hotline shifts per month. In addition to the hotline, the advocates will provide support when requested to accompany a survivor of sexual violence to the hospital for a forensic exam or police station to make a report. Volunteers must meet the following criteria:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Have a valid driver's license
- Complete our FREE 40-hour training program
- Live within one hour of Morristown Medical Center
- Consent to a background check
- Attend monthly team meetings
